Join us in the Fellowship Hall on **Sunday, January 27** at 5 p.m., as we present our summer mission plans. Hope to see you there!

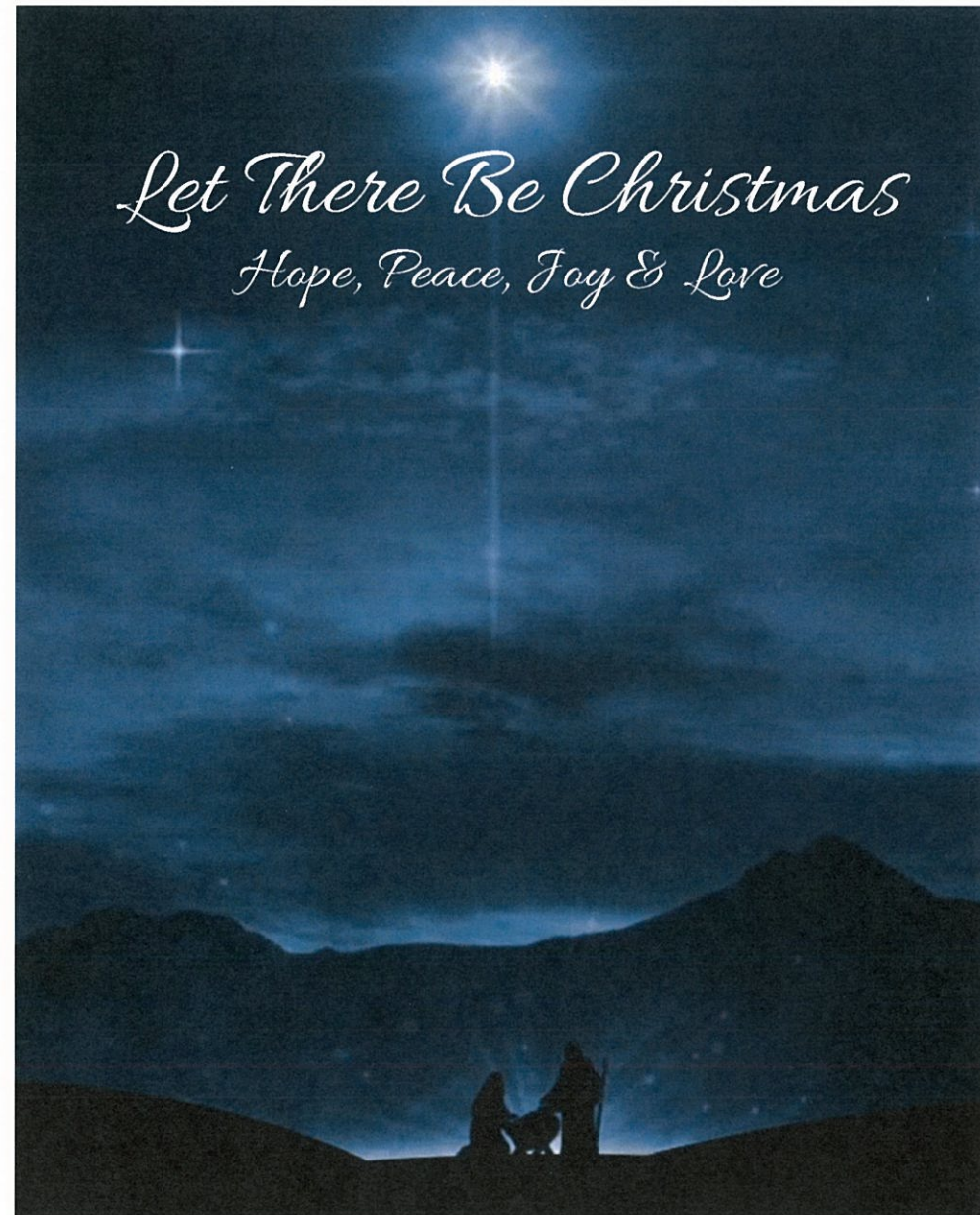
End of the Year Contributions 2018
